PASTOR'S NOTE

The day of resurrection! Earth, tell it out abroad, the Passover of gladness, the Passover of God. From death to life eternal, from sin's dominion free, our Christ has brought us over with hymns of victory.

From the first verse of the first Easter Hymn in our Book of Worship. "The Day of Resurrection" written by John of Damasus 696-754 AD. He was a scholar and "deep thinker" whose interests were quite diverse. John of Damascus was an Arab Christian monk, priest, hymnographer, and defender of the faith.

Easter Hymns proclaim the incredible "Good News" of the Resurrection of Christ on Easter Morn. The victory over the grave that ensures our life with God through Christ's triumph. The heavens are "joyful" and earth can sing the song of life eternal with God. It is no wonder that we often sing these hymns during the celebration of a loved one's passing. It is appropriate to be grieved by loss but the empty tomb is the sign of the immortal life with God.

2. We are continuing to collect clean, dry egg shells. Bring yours to the kitchen and add to the labeled container next to the microwave & we will give them to our composting members.

3. The Green team is partnering with Covenant Presbyterian church to recycle soft plastics. The most common item to be recycled is dry, unsoiled plastic grocery store bags. You know the ones you get when they ask paper or plastic? Other items that can be used are plastic bags you get when you mail order clothing, plastic overwrap on paper towels or toilet paper, air pillows, bubble wrap, cereal bags, clean plastic sandwich bags and zip lock bags.
