PASTOR'S NOTE

"...as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience... Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony." (Colossians 3:12, 14)

Beginning April 18, a group of Christ Lutheran members began a study of Sr. Joyce Rupp's book *Boundless* Compassion: Creating a Way of Life. (You are welcome to join us on Thursdays at 10:00am. See me for more details.) Members of the Thursday Lenten study of Sr. Rupp's *The* Cup of Our Life, appreciated her book so much that they wanted to dive right into another one.

Boundless Compassion begins with a quote from McNeill, Morrison, and Nouwen's 1983 work Compassion: A Reflection on the Christian Life: "Compassion askes us to go where it hurts, to enter places of pain, to share in brokenness, fear, confusion, and anguish. Compassion challenges us to cry out with those in misery, to mourn with those who are lonely, to week with those in tears. Compassion requires us to be weak with the weak, vulnerable with the vulnerable, and powerless with the powerless. Compassion means full immersion in the condition of being human."

Compassion is not just a warm feeling. It is not looking on and wishing things were different. It is more than a pat on the back and a few kind words. Compassion literally means to suffer (passion) with (com) – and then to be moved to action. For followers of Jesus, compassion means living like Christ and with Christ – all the way to the cross (and beyond.)

Of course, this kind of compassion is in no way easy. There is no doubt, however, that it is the life we are called to live with our Lord and with one another. Thanks be to God we were not meant to love others and the world God made on our own. We gather together in Christian community, as the congregation of Christ Lutheran Church, to equip and empower one another and to work together to be active witnesses to God's love.

Thank you! Thank you for all the ways you live God's compassion through the ministry we share at Christ Lutheran –meaningful worship, caring for one another, Green Team, Social Club, Habitat for Humanity, Family Promise, RAM House and so much more... Thank you for being the body of Christ, for living Christ's compassion at the corner of Grandin and Brandon and beyond!



- **2.** We are continuing to collect clean, dry egg shells. **Bring yours to the kitchen** and add to the labeled container next to the microwave & we will give them to our composting members.
- **13.** The Green team is partnering with Covenant Presbyterian church to recycle soft plastics. The most common item to be recycled is dry, unsoiled plastic grocery store bags. You know the ones you get when they ask paper or plastic? Other items that can be used are plastic bags you get when you mail order clothing, plastic overwrap on paper towels or toilet paper, air pillows, bubble wrap, cereal bags, clean plastic sandwich bags and zip lock bags. **Bring all soft plastics to the Coat Closet in the marked basket.**

FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT—MAY 2024

First, I would like to report that Cheri has taken on the role of Treasurer for the church. Judy, after many years of service to the congregation as the Treasurer, retired at the end of the year. We are so very grateful for all that she has done for Christ Lutheran, and for her help in preparing Cheri to serve in this capacity. Judy has agreed to remain a member of the Finance Committee. Next, in reporting on the budget, I would like to thank you for your generous giving that resulted in the church having revenue matching its expenses in 2023. As you may know, we were running in 2023 with income lagging expenses, but finished out the last several months on a strong trend. Thus far in 2024 our giving is again starting our running behind budget and expenses, about \$25,000 for the first three months. While we have had some high, unexpected expenses, we are fortunate to have some other investment funds that have been gifted to the church over the years, which performed well in the first quarter.

Finally, I would like to invite anyone interested in serving on the Finance Committee or assisting with related activities such as the audit committee to let me, or the church office know. We are always grateful for additional support. As well, I welcome any questions or suggestions you may have.
